RECIPE OF THE MONTH

This month's recipe is for **glazed pink** strawberry brownies!

1 box strawberry cake mix
2 eggs
1/3 cup oil
1 cup powdered sugar
½-2tb water/milk
Optional mix-ins (white chocolate chips, strawberries, etc)

- Mix strawberry cake mix, eggs, oil, and optional mix-ins until well combined.
 Spread batter in a 9 X 13 pan lined with parchment paper.
- Bake at 350 degrees for 15 minutes or until done in center. Be careful to remove before edges brown!



RECIPE OF THE MONTH

 To create the glaze, mix powdered sugar and water/milk until smooth. Pour glaze over brownies while hot. Spread glaze to edges, allowing it to drip down Allow brownies to cool and glaze to set before cutting into squares (or hearts for Valentine's Day).
