at BMHS (35 River St, Billerica, MA).







Lemon Cupcakes

These little cupcakes are light, fluffy and packed with bright lemon flavor. Topped with a not-too-sweet cream cheese frosting, they are both well-balanced and indulgent — and easy to prepare in one bowl!

Ingredients:

Yields:

- ∘ ½ cup unsalted butter (1 stick)
- 1 cup granulated sugar
- 3 tbsp finely grated lemon zest plus ¼
 cup lemon juice (from 2 to 3 lemons)
- o 2 eggs
- ∘ 1/4 cup whole milk
- o 2 tsp pure vanilla extract
- ∘ 1½ cups all purpose flour
- ∘ 1½ tsp baking powder
- \circ ½ tsp kosher salt

- 8 oz cream cheese
- ∘ ½ cup unsalted butter (1 stick)
- 2 tbsp finely grated lemon zest (from 2 lemons)
- ∘ ½ tsp kosher salt
- 2 cups confectioners' sugar

Directions:

- 1. Heat the oven to 350 degrees. Line a standard 12-cup muffin tin with liners.
- 2. Prepare the cupcakes: In a large bowl, with an electric mixer on medium, beat the butter and granulated sugar until fluffy, about 2 minutes. Beat in the lemon zest and juice. Beat in the eggs. Beat in the milk and vanilla, scraping down the sides of the bowl as necessary.
- 3. Add the flour, baking powder and salt to the butter mixture. Beat until just combined. Divide the batter evenly among the muffin cups. Bake until the tops of the cupcakes spring back when lightly touched, 18 to 20 minutes. Transfer to a wire rack to cool.
- 4. Meanwhile, prepare the frosting: In a large bowl, with an electric mixer on medium, beat the cream cheese until smooth and creamy. Add the butter, lemon zest and kosher salt; beat to combine. Beat in the confectioners' sugar on low speed.
- 5. Top the cooled cupcakes with the frosting. (The frosted cupcakes are best the day they're made, but you can make the cakes in advance and freeze them for up to 1 month in an airtight container. Thaw at room temperature to serve.)
