Bill Launzon

Bill has been playing drums professionally in the Boston area for over 40 years. He started drum lessons at 8 years old and began playing professionally at age 18 at restaurants, clubs, shows, and



hotels. He recently finished a 14 year engagement with the Jambalaya Jazz Band which was led by Jim Kilroy. The jazz band featured horn players Mel Deveaux (Berklee College, Army Band), Paul Monet, Craig Ball (White Heat Swing Orchestra), Jeff Stout (Berklee professor, Buddy Rich Big Band), Mike Peipman, and Neil Flewelling. He studied drums with Donn Carr (Berklee College, owner of the Donn Carr Drum studio), and taught at Donn's studio with a full schedule of 40 students per week. He also attends master drum classes with Dave Weckl, Steve Smith, Pat Petrillo, and Horacio Hernandez. Bill enjoys teaching students of all ages and level of ability. His goal is for students to have fun while learning the fundamentals of becoming a solid, well-rounded drummer.

Peach Cobbler

Ingredients

- 6 large or 7 medium peaches, thinly sliced
- 1 1/2 teaspoons fresh lemon juice
- 3/4 cup all purpose flour
- 1/4 cup cane sugar
- 1/4 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1/4 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 cup melted coconut oil or unsalted butter
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- Vanilla ice cream, for serving



Directions

- Preheat the oven to 400°F and grease a 9x13-inch baking dish with coconut oil.
- Layer the peaches into the bottom of the baking dish and drizzle the lemon juice over the peaches.
- In a medium bowl, mix the flour, sugar, cinnamon, baking soda, and salt. Add the coconut oil and vanilla and combine until the mixture forms a crumbly dough. Sprinkle over the peaches and bake for 30 minutes, or until the mixture is just lightly browned on top and the peaches are juicy.
- Serve warm with vanilla ice cream.
