recipe of the Month

Supernatural Brownies

This is not your average brownie recipe--Nick Malgieri's 'supernatural' brownies contain half the normal amount of flour and a touch of brown sugar. This recipe makes for an extremely fudgey and moist brownie, so much so that it's almost supernatural!

Ingredients:

Yields approx. 15 large or 24 small brownies.

- 2 sticks / 16 tbsp butter + more for greasing
- 8 oz bittersweet chocolate
- 1 cup dark brown sugar
- 1 cup granulated sugar
- 4 eggs
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 2 tsp vanilla extract
- 1 cup flour
- 1/2 cup chopped walnuts (optional) or 3/4 cup whole walnuts



Directions:

- 1. Butter a 13" by 9" baking pan and line with buttered parchment paper. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
- 2. Melt butter and chocolate together in a double boiler or in the microwave in 30 second intervals, stirring after each interval. Stir in the dark brown sugar.
- 3. In a large bowl, whisk the white sugar and flour together; a little at a time, whisk in the eggs, vanilla, and salt.
- 4. Ensuring that the chocolate mixture has no lumps, stir-- not whisk!-- the mixture thoroughly into the egg mixture. If using chopped walnuts, stir them in.
- 5. Pour batter into prepared pan. If using whole walnuts, arrange on top of batter. Bake for 35 to 40 minutes, or until shiny and beginning to crack on top. Cool in pan or on rack.

For best results, bake a day before serving and store tightly wrapped in the fridge!

Watermelon Festival


Bring your family and friends to Chelmsford's Watermelon Festival, where you can shop around, participate in raffles, and enjoy fresh watermelon!
