Irish Soda Bread

Irish soda bread dough comes together in about 10 minutes. You need buttermilk, egg, flour, sugar, baking soda, salt, and butter.

Whisk the wet ingredients together.

Whisk the dry ingredients together.

Cut cold butter into the dry ingredients. Like scones and pie crust, cutting cold butter into the flour is a key step. Coating the flour in cold butter guarantees a lovely flaky texture.

You can use a fork, your hands, or a pastry cutter.


Add the wet ingredients.

Bring the dough together with your hands. You can watch me do this in the video tutorial above. Don't stress, it's really easy! Using a very sharp knife, score the dough. This allows the center to bake.

Bake until golden brown.
