A performance for families with children who have special needs was sponsored by Music Elements and the Jamie Lonto Music Scholarship fund. A Training for staff and teachers was held at Music Elements. Joanie, a visiting professional from Ohio, offered support in teaching children on the Autism spectrum and those with Sensory Processing issues.

Using original pieces of musical story and song, Joanie weaved for us images and narratives of what people who live with Autism and sensory processing issues deal with on a minute by minute, and daily basis. Joanie brought a new awareness using this effective teaching method to the professional musical teaching staff at Music Elements.
