# recipe of the month

Pumpkin Whoopie Pies

Pumpkin season is here, and what better way to celebrate it than by making these decadent pumpkin whoopie pies? These are a classic family recipe and for good reason: combining warm fall spices, pumpkin, and a layer of rich buttercream, these whoopie pies are the essence of Fall baking.

### **Ingredients:**

Yields approx. 12 whoopie pies

- 3 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 tsp salt
- 1 tsp baking powder
- 1 tsp baking soda
- 2 tbsp ground cinnamon
- 1 tbsp ground ginger
- 1 tbsp ground cloves
- 1 cup vegetable oil

- 3 cups pumpkin puree, chilled
- 2 large eggs
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 2 cups firmly packed dark brown sugar

### **Directions:**

For the cookies:

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Line two baking sheets with parchment paper or a nonstick baking mat; set aside.
- 2. In a large bowl, whisk together flour, baking powder, baking soda, and spices; set aside. In another large bowl, whisk together oil, pumpkin puree, eggs, and vanilla until well combined. Add brown sugar and whisk until combined. Sprinkle flour mixture over pumpkin mixture and whisk until fully incorporated.
- 3. Using a 1/4 cup ice cream scoop, drop dough onto prepared baking sheets, about 1 inch apart. Transfer to oven and bake until cookies are just starting to crack on top and a toothpick inserted into the center of each cookie comes out clean, about 15 minutes. Let cool completely on pan.

### For the filling:

1. Sift confectioners' sugar into a medium bowl; set aside. In the bowl of an electric mixer fitted with the paddle attachment, beat butter until smooth. Add cream cheese and beat until well combined, then confectioners' sugar and vanilla until just smooth.

### Assembly:

1. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper and set aside. Transfer filling to a disposable pastry bag-- or use a spoon!-- and pipe a large dollop of filling on the flat side of half of the cookies. Sandwich with the remaining cookies, lightly pressing down so that the filling spreads to the edge of the cookies. Transfer to prepared baking sheet and cover with plastic wrap. Enjoy!


